

Study Permit

Requirements:

- Students may provide language scores or not; if not, except for the English /French native speaker, the student should provide evidence to demonstrate the purpose of the study and the ability to reach the academic goal
- The student should provide the document about the language training if the student does not submit the language exam result
- The students should have at least CAD10,000 funds available for one year of living expenses in either their bank account or the parent's account for six months. Keep the funds in the bank for twelve months would be better if the source of the fund could not be approved documentary
- Applying for the Study Permit within Canada is a better way for the student who holds a post-secondary degree but registers with a post-secondary diploma, who does not have enough funding for the study, or is over 30 years old.

Service:

- Immigration Consulting and case evaluation
 - All necessary letter drafts including but not limited to
 - Study Plan
 - Finance Guarantee Letter
 - Employment Letter
- Submission Letter
- Fill up forms
- Preparation of related documents
- Correspondence with the IRCC for any necessary update
- AITP and reconsideration submission if the initial application got refused
- Assist with applying for school
- Coordinate with Language School, if applicable
- Communicate with the IRCC
- Provide the IRCC update regular

Service Fee: CAD2,000/person, subject to 13% HST, if applicable

The service fee does not include any fees charged by the third party and the government fee, like notarial fees, express delivery fees, medical exam fees, the international bank transaction fee(CAD17), the IRCC fee(CAD150), biometric collection(CAD85), ATIP (CAD5) , etc.
